# ADOPT-A-DOOR

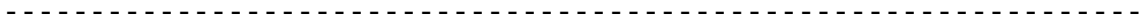

It allows teachers to immediately lock the door from inside the classroom during an emergency; acting as a quick and easy barricade. The NIGHTLOCK LOCKDOWN anchors securely to the floor and can withstand 1,100 pounds of force.

Each classroom door device costs \$60, and there are 396 classrooms in the district.
